

Vicar's Report

Last Sunday we considered the Syrophoenician woman who seemed to help Jesus expand his vision. As we think and pray about Spirit of the Wilderness, are there areas in which we need to expand ours?

That's what we'll be focusing on this Sunday—during church and then after at a brief meeting—11:45-12:15—to lay out “The State of the Mission.” to consider where we are at—in terms of program, finances, etc.—as we begin to turn a corner, expectant to see what God has put ahead of us.

These areas include:

- Rethinking our ministry as we grow—how do we continue to have strong lay involvement, with people functioning out of their gifts and passions? This will be part of preparation for my sabbatical.
- Training folks so that they can move into new ministry areas.
- A stewardship campaign for this next year.
- Our need to put SOTW on a more secure financial footing—we have some people who have offered to be part of this work—I'm calling them the Financial Wizards!
- Continued learning opportunities—forums, historical services, small groups, Deepening Roots—perhaps more movie/book groups?
- Outreach possibilities including Ruby's Pantry and mentoring at the Y.
- Ongoing balance of care for those within our walls and those outside—beginning to think toward our next Entry Points art exhibit, for example.
- We need some new people willing to serve on the Bishop's Committee beginning later this fall.

What am I missing? What are you feeling tugged about? Just as Mariano brought us the Cody's Closet idea, which has been blessed and multiplied—what would you want to bring?

My sense is that this meeting will provide an important place for us to stop and see where we're at, as we offer our loaves and fishes, and as we “step out of the boat”! One of the biggest challenge to any church is to hold onto what is good, but to be willing to keep moving and changing—expanding the vision. Because that's what God is like.

After our meeting on the 24th, we'll go out to Poplar Lake for a social at Ron and Sue's.
